Mobile Treatment services are intended to support those consumers who have not been able to take advantage of more traditional mental health services.

The Mobile Treatment team is comprised of a psychiatrist, a nurse, a vocational specialist, an addictions specialist, a peer counselor, an office manager, and a social worker. The team offers a comprehensive array of services to assist consumers with becoming more stable and productive in their community.

Outreach and Engagement:

Lower Shore Clinic's Mobile Treatment Team (MTS) will provide client specific and appropriate psychiatric, vocational, rehabilitation, and substance abuse services. MTS team will provide outreach and engagement services at client's home, work, or any other appropriate location chosen by consumer.

MTS team shall provide case management and advocacy as indicated to assist client in becoming as independent as possible, including:

Individual, Family, and/or Group services and assistance with -

- Psychiatric intake and symptom management, stabilization, and therapy
- medication services, including medication monitoring
- budgeting and money management
- gaining entitlements
- finding and maintaining employment, volunteer positions
- finding and maintaining housing
- connecting to community resources
- interpersonal and family problems
- maintaining good mental health
- utilizing natural supports
- health promotion and training

Adults in need of services are assessed by clinical staff to determine the client's needs, strengths, resources and also receive a psychiatric evaluation which includes history, mental status examination, and diagnosis.

Treatment plans are developed based on the admission screening and are reviewed every 3 months, at a minimum.

If treatment by the Mobile Treatment Team is not indicated, staff will notify the referring agency as well as the client within 10 days with an explanation of the decision.

We accept Maryland Medical Assistance, Medicare, and Uninsured clients that meet state eligibility.

Lower Shore Clinic MTS provides services primarily to adult residents of Southern Caroline, Dorchester, Somerset, Wicomico, and Worcester counties.
